



Disciplinary action may be taken when any participant verbally and/or physically abuses and/or threatens another participant and/or any Intramural Sports employee(s). The following guidelines may be enforced when unsportsmanlike behavior occurs by a participant, coach, and/or spectator(s):

- Any participant ejected from an intramural sports contest under any circumstance may be suspended for a minimum of one game and must attend a hearing with the Intramural Ejection Board.**
- Any participant who is ejected from an intramural sports contest is ineligible for all intramural activities (including other sports) until he/she has met with the Intramural Ejection Board.**
- Any participant who physically threatens and/or contacts an Intramural Sports employee will be suspended indefinitely, attend a hearing before the Intramural Ejection Board, and be referred to the Office of Student Conduct.**



Guidelines (cont.)

- Any participant who physically threatens and/or contacts another intramural participant may be suspended for the remainder of the sport season (including playoffs), may be referred to the Office of Student Conduct and **MUST** attend a hearing before the Intramural Ejection Board.
- Any participant and/or spectator leaving the bench/sideline during an altercation will be suspended for the remainder of the sport season (including playoffs) and attend a hearing before the Intramural Ejection Board.
- Any participant who verbally abuses and/or threatens an Intramural Sports employee and/or another intramural participant will be suspended for a minimum of two games and **MUST** attend a hearing before the Intramural Ejection Board. They may also be subject to referral to the Office of Student Conduct.
- Postgame incidents involving any verbal and/or physical abuse of Intramural Sports employees, other participants, and/or Intramural equipment and/or facilities will be dealt with as an extension of the contest and will be considered on a case by case basis.



Examples of Unsportsmanlike Behavior could include, but are not limited to:

- **Shoving or striking an opponent and/or employee of University Recreation/Intramural Sports.**
- **Unnecessary delay of game**
- **Leaving bench/sideline to participate in an altercation**
- **Arguing and/or being uncooperative with an Intramural Sports employee (Officials, Site Manager, etc.)**
- **Abusive language to an opponent and/or Intramural Sports employee (Officials, Site Manager, etc.)**
- **Racial Slurs**
- **Any behavior deemed inappropriate by Intramural Sports and University Recreation staff.**
