



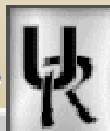
Playing for Multiple Teams

•Participants may play for multiple teams as long as they are in different divisions and/or blocks.

For example, a participant could play on two (2) Men's Independent, one (1) Fraternity, and one (1) CoRec team as long as that individual is not in the same block of play during the regular season.

•No more than five (5) participants from one team may also play for the same team in another block in the same division. This rule does not apply to participants who want to play on multiple teams together in different divisions, such as playing on one Men's team and one Co-Rec team.

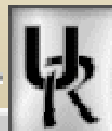
Playing for Multiple Teams (cont.)

•When the playoffs begin, players must choose which team they play on if they are a member of two (2) or more teams in the same division. Players may, for example, still play on both Men's and CoRec teams for the duration of each playoffs.

•The Intramural Sports program is not responsible for schedule conflicts caused by a participant playing on multiple teams. If a conflict arises, that person will have to make a choice as to which team they will play for in that contest.

Participants who cannot prove their eligibility will not be permitted to participate in any Intramural sports/activities.
